I am in receipt of your letter dated March 23, 2007 informing me of President Dr. Martin C. Jischke's recommendation requesting me to waive remaining confidentiality under Executive Memorandum (EM) C-22 for the review just concluded.

In the interest of openness and full disclosure in responding to Chairman Brad Miller's Committee, I am confirming my agreement to waive confidentiality under EM C-22. I understand that Purdue has already forwarded certain documents to Purdue and I would appreciate receiving a copy of the documents that were forwarded.


I firmly believe that this forthright letter, Statement and respective attachments to Chairman Miller will demonstrate my good-faith full cooperation, once and for all clear
